QUALIFICATIONS

FACULTY OF AGRICULTURE

Professor

1. An eminent scholar with Ph.D. qualification(s) in the concerned/allied/relevant discipline and published work of high quality, actively engaged in research with evidence of published work with a minimum of 10 publications as books and/or research/policy papers.
2. A minimum of 10 years of teaching/research/extension education experience of which at least 3 years should have been spent as Assoc. Prof. at an AGP of Rs. 9000/- or in equivalent position in University/college, and/or National level institutions including experience of guiding candidates for research at doctoral level.
3. Contribution to educational innovation, design of new curricula and courses, and technology-mediated teaching learning process.
4. A minimum score as stipulated in the Academic Performance Indicator (API) based Performance Based Appraisal System (PBAS), set out in Univ. Regulation.

Associate Professor


1. A consistently good academic record with a Ph.D. Degree in the concerned/allied/relevant discipline.
2. **A minimum of 8 years experience in teaching/ research and/or extension education as Asstt. Prof. or equivalent position in a University/ College or Accredited Research Institution (excluding the period spent in Ph.D. research subject to a maximum of 3 years) with evidence of published work and a minimum of 5 publications as books and/or research/policy papers. "**
2. Contribution to educational innovation, design of new curricula and courses, and technology – mediated teaching learning process with evidence of having guided doctoral candidates at doctoral and master level.
3. A minimum score as stipulated in the Academic Performance Indicator (API) based Performance Based Appraisal System (PBAS), set out in Univ. Regulation.

Assistant Professor

1. A consistently good academic record with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade of 6.5/10.0 or 3.2/4.0 in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the Master's Degree level in a relevant subject from an Indian University or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign University.
2. Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC/CSIR/ASRB in the concerned or relevant subject or similar test accredited by the UGC/CSIR/ASRB etc.

For the candidates having Master's degree, NET shall remain compulsory along with one publication in NAAS (National Academy of Agricultural Sciences, New Delhi) rated refereed journal for recruitment to the post of Assistant Professor and equivalent in the

disciplines in which NET is conducted. Essentiality of NET can be waved off for the candidates holding Ph.D. degree provided it has been done with course work as prescribed by the UGC Regulations 2009, and the candidate has atleast two full length publications having a NAAS rating not less than 4, on the last date of submission of application. Those candidates with Ph.D.degree without course work will not qualify for NET exemption

Desirable

1. Ph.D. degree in the relevant subject

Relevant alternative subjects prescribed for the following subjects as under

S.No	Subject	Alternative subject
1.	Agricultural Statistics	Masters degree in Statistics/Mathematics with specialization in Agricultural Statistics and/or followed by a certificate/diploma or Ph.D. from IASRI/ISI
2.	Agril.Extension Education	Master's degree in Dairy Extension Education
3.	Agril. Economics	Master's degree in Dairy Economics
4.	Plant Physiology	Master's degree in Crop Physiology

Note: Candidates holding Bachelor's degree in Science prior to a Master's degree in Agriculture shall also be eligible for appointment in Agriculture Faculty.

Asstt. Librarian

1. A Master's degree in Library Science/Information Science/Documentation or an equivalent professional degree with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and a consistently good academic record with knowledge of computerization of library
2. Qualifying the National Level Test conducted for the purpose by the UGC or any other agency approved by the UGC.


Desirable:

Ph.D. degree in Library/Information Science

General Instructions:

1. Number of post(s) can be increased or decreased maintaining roster system.
2. Applications and *Score Card* received after last date or incomplete application forms will be rejected without making any further reference and no fee will be refunded. University shall not be responsible for any delay.

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
3. Reservation shall be provided to SC/ST/OBC/SBC candidate as per Rajasthan Universities Teachers and Officers Selection for Appointment Act 1974 (Act No. 18 of 1984) for bonafide residents of Rajasthan State as per Government of Rajasthan Rules.
4. University reserves the right not to fill up any or all posts advertised.
5. Where the number of applications received in response to this advertisement is large in number and it is not convenient or possible for the University to interview all those candidates, the University may restrict the number of candidates based on academic achievements and experience in the relevant field by screening of applications.
6. The candidates who had applied in response to earlier advertisement No.2/2011 dated 8-11-2011 for the positions of concerned discipline of *Associate Professor* are requested to resubmit applications (if they fulfill the present qualifications, etc.)and *Score Card* in the format available at University website www.raubikaner.org. Such candidates need not pay application fee again. In case, new application form is not received by due date, it will be assumed that he/she is not interested to apply for the concerned post.
7. A relaxation of 5% will be provided (from 55% to 50%) in the marks at the Master's level for SC/ST category candidates.
8. Pension and other allowances will be admissible to selected candidates as per financial rules of the University modified from time to time.
9. Any candidate joining the University will be placed on probation period for two years from the date of joining. During the probation period, the selected candidate will be paid fixed emoluments permissible as per GOR rules applicable and will be placed on regular pay scale after successful completion of the probation period.
10. The selected candidates will be governed under the rules adopted by the Board of Management vide its Resolution No. RAU/BOM-67/2007-1/1042 dated 23.01.2007 and notified by Notification No. 496 dated 06.02.2007.

11. No candidate shall be eligible for appointment to the service who has more than two children on or after 01.06.2002.

- Provided that the candidate having more than two children shall not be deemed to be disqualified for appointment so long as the number of children he/she has on 1st June, 2002, does not increase.
- Provided further that where a candidate has one child from earlier delivery but more than one child are born out of a single subsequent delivery, the children so born shall be deemed to be one entity while counting the total number of children.

12. Envelope containing application form should be **superscribed** with "APPLICATION FORM FOR THE POST OF _____".

13. **The candidates are required to enclose attested photocopies of all documents related to qualification they possess and proof of other related information. It is compulsory to write the Enclosure No. related to photocopies attached of documents/qualifications, otherwise the application form will be treated as incomplete and rejected without any information. Proof of documents/qualifications received after the due date will not be accepted.**
