Awards and Honours

- Dr. S. K. Bairwa, Assistant Professor, ARS, Sriganganagar got District Level Award by District Collector on Jan 26, 2016 as a collaborative author for developing new mustard varieties RGN-298 & RGN-303 and for developing new technologies for disease management in mustard & wheat.
- Dr. I. J. Gulati, Dean COA was bestowed with Gold Medal Award-2015; Dr. S. L. Godara, ZDR, ARS, Bikaner with Leadership Award-2015 and Er. A. K. Singh with Special Research Award-2015 by the Soil Conservation Society of India, New Delhi in the National Seminar held at SKRAU, Bikaner during Feb 17-19, 2016. Nineteen other awards were also conferred to the scientists of SKRAU, Bikaner in Best Paper and Poster Presentation categories.

New Projects Sanctioned

- An ICAR sponsored Extramural Research Project worth ₹ 22.50 lakh 'Supply -Demand Analysis of Professional Agricultural Human Resource in Northern India' was approved and implemented from January 19, 2016.
- A one year project worth ₹ 12.0 lakh has been sanctioned by United Phosphorus Limited to College of Agriculture, Bikaner.

- Eleven new projects worth ₹ 497.3 lakhs under RKVY have been sanctioned to various units of the university.

National Conference / Workshops / Trainings organized

- A three days workshop of AICRP on Arid Zone Fruit (Date Palm) was organized during Feb 4-6, 2016 by ARS, Directorate of Research with participation of 55 scientists from different parts of country.



25th National Conference on Natural Resource Management in Arid and Semi Arid Ecosystem for Climate Resilient Agriculture and Rural Development, held at SKRAU, Bikaner

- The 25th National Conference on 'Natural Resource Management in Arid and Semi-arid Ecosystem for Climate Resilient Agriculture and Rural Development' was organized by the Soil Conservation Society of India, New Delhi in collaboration with Directorate of Research, SKRAU, Bikaner during Feb 17-19, 2016 with participation of 362 scientists from across the country by Directorate of Research. State Minister for Mines, Forest and Environment, Government of Rajasthan Shri Rajkumar Rinwa was the Chief Guest of the Inaugural Ceremony. The conference was chaired by Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, SKRAU, Prof. B. R. Chhipa.
- Directorate of Extension Education organized a 8 days model training course on 'Integrated Farming System in Arid and Semi-arid Regions' during Feb 22-29, 2016 with the participation of 19 trainees from 5 different states. This training course was sponsored by Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers' Welfare, GoI.

One year Horticulture Supervisor Training Course (2016-17), sponsored by Department of Horticulture, GoR under National Horticulture Mission, was inaugurated by the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, Prof. B. R. Chhipa on June 15, 2016 with 25 youths from various districts of Rajasthan as trainees.

Significant research contributions

- Clusterbean variety HG 2-20 included in PoP for rainfed conditions in zone 1b
- Two varieties of groundnut viz., HNG 123 and RG 425 (RAJ Durga) were included in PoP in zone 1c
- In groundnut, seed treatment with Tebuconazole 2DS @ 1.5 g/kg + furrow application of T. viride @ 4.0 kg enriched with 50 kg FYM/ha + Broadcasting of T. viride @ 4.0 kg enriched with 50 kg FYM/ha at 40 DAS + Two foliar spray of Tebuconazole 25.9% @ 1.0 ml/litre starting from initiation of foliar disease and second spray at 15 days interval was found most appropriate and effective for management of collar rot and leaf spot disease in zone 1b.
- In groundnut, ST with T. viride @ 10 g/kg + furrow application of T. viride @ 10 kg enriched with 250 kg FYM/ha + drenching of T. viride @ 5.0 gm/litre at 70-75 days after sowing has been recommended for effective management of root rot of groundnut in zone 1b.
- Management of sucking insect in mungbean, application of dichlorvas 76 % EC @ 0.50 + quinalphos 35% EC @ 1.0 ml/lit of water were effective in zone 1b.
- In sesame, seed treatment with imidachlorprid 70 WG @ 5.0 g/kg seed + two spray of thiomethoxam @ 0.5 g/litre at 50 and 65 DAS + one spray of sterptocycline 150 ppm + copper oxychloride @ 2.0 g/litre at 75 DAS was found effective for phyllody management in zone 1b
- Post emergant application of Imazethapyr + Pendimethalin (2+30%) @ 2400 ml/ha

(Commercial dose) in 500 litre water as pre emergence in mung bean to control both grassy and broad leaved weeds in the presence of proper soil moisture in zone 1c.

- Seed treatment with fipronil (5% SC) @ 4 ml/kg seed of moth bean and cluster bean for effective management of sucking pest in zone 1c.

Farm Implements and Machinery Testing and Training Centre

- Farm Implements and Machinery Testing and Training Centre, Central Workshop of SKRAU organized training for farmers at Benisar village in which 152 farmers were trained. A training was organized for 14 students also. During the period 28 Commercial Testing Reports were released by the centre.

International Yoga Day

International Yoga Day was celebrated by the students and staff of the university on June 21, 2016. Yoga camp was organized in university campus during June 16-21, 2016 under supervision of Yoga Practitioners. The participants were awarded certificates on completion of the camp. Essay competition was also organized by Directorate of Students' Welfare.

- An exhibition was put up by Directorate of Extension Education in the Farmers' Fair organized by RAJUVAS and ATMA on February 27, 2016.
- Under Pradhan Mantri Fasal Beema Yojna (PMFBY), a Farmers' Fair was organized by KVK, Bikaner on April 30, 2016. The chief guest of the function was Shri Arjun Ram Meghwal, MP, Bikaner and Hon'ble Vice Chancellor of SKRAU, Prof. B. R.

Chhipa presided over the main function. Around 3500 farmers and farm women of the district participated in the fair. Under the same scheme, farmers' fair was also organized at KVK Jhunjhunu on April 3, 2016 and KVK Sriganganagar on April 4, 2016.

- Total 185 demonstrations were laid out by KVKs on 74 ha area, out of which, 85 demonstrations were on oil seed crops, 25 on pulses and rest on other crops.
- The Directorate of Millet Development, Department of Agriculture and Farmers' Welfare allotted a three days visit to Centre of Excellence on Pearl Millet, CCS, HAU, Hissar during March 2-4, 2016. A group of 27 persons, including 20 farmers, three scientists and four extension workers visited the centre.
