Before taking up the Agenda, the Chairman desired the introduction of members of the council.

Thereafter the Agenda items were taken.

AU/AC-13/2000-1/01: Confirming the minutes of 12th meeting of Academic Council held on 20th July, 1999.

Resolved that the minutes be confirmed subject to following observation.

AU/AC-12/1999-1/02: Item No. AU/AC-11/98-1/03 A sub committee was constituted to further review the allocation of scheme 411 to Agronomy or Soil Science Department. Since the committee has not yet submitted its report and that with the bifurcation of Agriculture University three members are not in jurisdiction of RAU, Bikaner therefore, it was resolved that another committee consisting of the following may be constituted to further review the issue.

1. Dean, SKNCA, Jobner
2. Dean, COA, Beechwal, Bikaner
3. Head of Deptt., Agronomy
4. Head of Deptt., Soil Sc. & Agril. Chemistry

The committee may submit its report by 3rd week of Feb., 2000.

As regards the suggestion of Dr. S.B.S. Yadav, Dean, PGS considering one supernumerary seat for Ph.D. admission to STS's instead of two. Since there was no error in recording the minutes as per decision, hence, the suggestion was not agreed.

Rule No. 18.6(b) The date of correction certificate and submission of bound thesis will be the date of degree award in PDC.

Business management at RAU, Bikaner.

After discussion at length, it was resolved that the qualifications for recruitment of Director and Teachers and course contents of MBA degree in the Institute of Agri. Business Management at RAU, BKN be referred to the following Management Experts Group:

- i. Prof. Udai Pareek
- ii. Prof. S.S. Acharya
- iii. Dr. G.K. Sharma, Director Institute of Agri. Business Management, and
- iv. Dr. Anil Kumar, Director P & M will assist them. Thereafter the recommendations of the above group may be further discussed with the expert of IIM Ahmdabad and IRMA, Anand.

Further resolved that on receipt of recommendations from the Management Expert Group and also the discussions from the experts of IIM and IRMA, the Vice-Chancellor is authorised to approve the qualifications & course contents.

- ii. The representation of elected teachers in BOM will be governed as per the provisions of the Model Act of ICAR, as the existing Act of RAU is also to be revised based on ICAR Model Act.
- iii. The payment of arrears on account of revised UGC pay scale will be made after receipt of funds from the state Govt.
- iv. To increase the number of seats in Ph.D. courses for inservice Teachers, the consideration of point was dropped.
- v. Amendment in Academic Council rule for election of Asstt. Prof./ Assoc. Prof. It is as per provisions of Act & Statutes of RAU, However, the present Act of RAU

- is also going to revise based on Model Act of ICAR.
- vi. To start placement cell and coaching for competitive examination like ASRB, IAS, IFS & RAS for providing more employment opportunities to the students, the council agreed in principle. The Director Students Welfare will submit the plan for exploring the facilities to the students.

1. For giving weightage / eligibility only 10+2 passed with Agriculture/ Home Sci. candidates be considered eligible for Joint Entrance Test (JET) and the candidate passed with Biology/ Mathematics group be not considered for eligibility.
2. The syllabus for JET be prescribed as per syllabus of 10+2 Agriculture faculty of Board of Secondary Education Rajasthan, Ajmer.
3. The Traditional System be started in under graduate classes and the semester system be stopped.
4. To allot 5% quota in admission to the wards (Son/ Daughter) of Teaching and Non Teaching staff after clearing JET and they may be given admission on the place of their choice for study.

After discussion, the council did not agree for the item No. 1,2,3, & 4 and Resolved that the present practice be continued.

Resolved that the recommendations be referred back to the Board of Studies as the External Members of BOS were not invited in the meeting. It was desired that the External members be invited as per provisions of BOS.

 - (iv) Plant Pathology
 - (v) LPM & Food Nutrition
3. To start P.G. classes in the following discipline:
 - (i) Veterinary Pharmacology
 - (ii) Veterinary Extension Education
 - (iii) Entomology, Plant Pathology & Biotechnology
 - (iv) Home Science Extension Education
 - (v) Textile & Clothing
 - (vi) Child Development
4. Better Research facilities for P.G. 7 Ph.D. Studies in terms of Extra grant for Instruments & Library (Journals)
5. Improvement in teaching and research environment of University
 - (i) Provide teaching aids like epidiascope, overhead projector, slide projector etc.
 - (ii) Model lecture theatres may be built at every college campus.
 - (iii) More staff in libraries be provided so that working hours of library be increased.
 - (iv) Every college library should be provided with Internet facility.
6. To provide more employment opportunities for students, start placement cell and coaching for competitive examinations like IAS, IFS, RAS, ASRB & other such examinations.

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7. Recommendation should be send to concerned authority to include home Science subject in RAS, IAS other such examinations.
8. Stipend and fellowship for veterinary and agricultural students should be increased, the fellowship and stipend allowance should be at par with ICAR fellowship & stipend.
9. Centre for conduction of NET, S.L.E.T. and other such exams. should be allotted in Bikaner.
10. To facilitate P.G and Ph.D. students with married resident hostel at every college campus.

Resolved that

1. The council agreed for holding convocation.
2. Ph.D. programme in the disciplines of Agronomy & Ag. Economics has been approved.
3. P.G. programme has also been approved in the subject of Bio-Technology, Plant Pathology, Entomology, Home Science Extension Education and Human Development & Family Studies.
4. Agreed for providing better research facilities etc.
5. Agreed in principle.
6. Agreed in principle, The DSW will submit the plan for exploring the facilities to the students and also placement of cell.
7. The State Govt. may be moved for the same.
8. The State Govt./ ICAR may be moved for the same.
9. The ICAR/ ASRB may be moved for opening a centre for conducting NET etc. in Bikaner.
10. Agreed in Principle, subject to availability of funds.

Before concluding the meeting the Vice-Chancellor informed the council about the MOU dated 19.1.2000 signed with the State Govt. giving undertaking for implementing the points mentioned there-in with-in a period of four months as an assurance to Govt. of Rajasthan to enable it to release the full payment of instalments of Block Grant. The Registrar then read the MOU.

Dr. G.K. Sharma, Director Agril. Business Management thanked the Vice-Chancellor for convening the meeting of Academic Council after his taking over.
