Dr.D.N.Ram, Dr.(Mrs.)P.Sundaram, Secretary (Agriculture),
Secretary (Animal Husbandry) and Secretary (Higher Education)
conveyed their inability to attend the meeting. Sh.Surendra Pal
Singh and Dr.S.Nagarajan did not attend the meeting.

At the outset, the Chairman and the members of the Board expressed sorrow on the sad demise of Shri S.P.S.Bhandari, Ex-Vice-Chancellor of University of Udaipur on 14th April, 1994.

The Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor warmly welcomed new members of the Board: Dr.B.S.Yadav, Prof. R.P.Singh, Shri Shiv Kishore Sanadhya, Dr.P.C.Gupta and Dr.S.K.Purohit. The Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor remarked that these celebrities representing technical expertise and intellectual leadership would provide valuable guidance for articulation of the vital concerns of RAU and thus immensely upgrade the capacity of the Board to contribute to accelerated development of the University for the service of the State.

The Vice-Chancellor appreciated the invaluable services rendered by the outgoing members: Prof.G.M.Reddy, Dr.Ranbir Singh, Dr.J.S.P.Yadav, Shri R.R.Mehta, Sh.Zabar Singh and Dr.S.L.Intodia, all of whom, he expressed, were committed to furthering the ideals of higher education.

Dr.P.C.Jain welcomed Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, Dr.R.K.Patel on behalf of academia and the Board members. He stated that the University has proud privilege to have an internationally acclaimed scientist as a Vice-Chancellor, Dr.R.K.Patel, he said, is a unique blend of a fine administrator and a great human being. Conveying unanimous confidence of the Board members in him, Dr.Jain expressed that he was confident that RAU would make an enhanced contribution to the prosperity of the State under the dynamic leadership of Dr.Patel.

The Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor thanked Dr.P.C.Jain and the members of the Board for the welcome. He expressed that prior to 1987, Rajasthan Agricultural University was just a wing of a multifaculty university that somehow learnt to live

with a blurred focus, confused priorities and diffused action.

But that style of thinking and working would not enable us to

play a crucial role in enforcing change in plight of agriculture
in the State. Conceptualizing mandates of various units of

RAU, he urged that well orchestrated efforts should be made to

achieve the following objectives:

- (a) Imparting education in agriculture and allied sciences.
- (b) Advancement of learning and research work in agriculture and allied sciences.
- (c) Undertaking extension education programme specially for the rural people of the Rajasthan State.

He commented that the vast number of scientists of RAU is impressive overall and is comparable to the best anywhere in India, the faculty, however, does require build up of a scientific culture where a quest for excellence and a conscious attempt to encourage talent prevail.

Calling for increased relevance of research efforts, the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor demanded that the scientific and technical creativity should serve the man behind the plough by providing him the needed inputs like certified seed/TFL seed, and the man tending the cattle by making him available facilities of AI centres and other technical know-how, inputs and services.

He remarked that in past 2 months, he has interacted with scientists, teachers and extensionists at various meetings and his impression is that while some excellent efforts have been made by the faculty, these have not received the appreciation they deserve. A major reason for this has been poor linkages between RAU and the farming community. He emphasized that each unit of RAU should build the bridges between the place of technology generation and place of technology application. could best be done if each unit adopted at least one village to demonstrate to the farmer, fellow-scientist and visitor the relevant, practicable & cost-effective technologies generated by RAU and adaptability of technologies generated elsewhere. Further, he stressed that live-stock component should form integral part of the Village Adoption Programme. In wake of the changing economic scene. the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor suggested that farmers be encouraged to grow crops like isabgol, soybean, spices, oilseeds etc. which have great potential after value addition.

AU/BOM-30/94-1/517: Considering conversion of the post of Dairy Engineer to that of Associate Professor of Dairy Engineering.

Resolved that as recommended by the Finance Committee, the post of Dairy Engineer in the existing pay-scale of 3000-4500 may be upgraded to that of Associate Professor of Dairy Engineering in the pay scale of 3700-5700. However, the upgradation shall come into effect only when the budget provision has been approved by the State Government.

AU/BOM-30/94-1/518: Reporting orders passed by the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor in anticipation of the approval of BOM and conveyed by COE to the Dean, College of Home Science, Udaipur vide letter No.COE/RAU/Secy/94/2365 dated 24.3.1994 for use of unfairmeans in 1993 examination by Miss Seema Tandon, student of Final Year (5-year-course of B.Sc.(H.Sc.) whose present

examination (1993) only has been cancelled, although the review sub-committee recommended cancellation of her present examination (1993) and also one subsequent examination under Rule b(ii) of Unfairmeans.

The Board confirmed the orders passed by the Vice-Chancellor.

AU/BOM-30/94-1/519: Considering the status report on the functioning of KVKs, submitted by Director, Extension Education Udaipur, desired vide Res.No.AU/BOM-29/93-3/509(a).

Dr.P.C.Jain presented the status report on the functioning of KVKs. The Board desired that the following steps be initiated.

- i) Early appointments on posts lying vacant.
- ii) Farm land of KVKs be fenced.
- iii) Farm equipment and machinery in KVKs specially tractors etc. be purchased.
  - iv) KVKs' buildings be constructed wherever required.

Prof.R.P.Singh suggested that the report on KVKs submitted by the QRT to ICAR may be obtained and action taken on this report may be put up in the next meeting of the Board.

AU/BOM-30/94-1/520: Considering the brief resume of Agricultural Development Project and steps taken for its implementation in RAU, as desired vide Res.No.AU/BOM-29/93-3/509 (b).

Dr.S.L.Mathur presented the resume of ADP which the Board noted.

<u>AU/BOM-30/94-1/521</u>: Considering the paper on research highlights of Zone-I-a together with list of research publications based on research findings received from Director Research, RAU, Bikaner as desired vide Res. No. AU/BOM-29/93-3/509 (c).

The Director Research(Ag.) presented basic information about the working of Directorate of Research since its inception. Later, the Assoc.Director, ARS, Mandor presented significant achievements and research highlights of ARS, Mandor (Zone I-a) which the Board noted and appreciated.

AU/BOM-30/94-1/522 : Considering the issue moved by Dr.(Mrs.)
P.Sundaram, Dr.S.L.Intodia and Sh.Jabar Singh for granting certain
benefits under carrer advancement scheme vide Res.No.AU/BOM-29/93-3/
509 (d).

After detailed discussions and considering the practice being followed in other universities, the Board resolved as under:

- (i) As proposed in Rule No.2(1) (a) of the Career Advancement Scheme, adhoc period as Assistant Professor followed by a regular selection be counted for the purpose of career advancement scheme since it is already in vogue in other universities of the state.
- (ii) Since the benefit of placement under senior scale or the selection scale is to be given to the teachers from the date they become eligible for the same, already exists in Rule No.6 of the Career Advancement Scheme, the same may be implemented and action be taken accordingly.
- (iii) Since the pay of an Assistant Professor placed under senior/selection scale is being fixed in accordance with the accepted norms of the Govt. of Rajasthan and Rule No.26 of RSR.

it was felt that no further ammendment in the existing rule is required.

(iv) The matter of counting the period of service rendered as

Lecturer for granting benefit under carrer advancement scheme be

deferred, since this matter is subjudice and be referred for

further examination and legal advice.

AU/BOM-30/94-1/523: Considering reservation for backward classes @ 21% of the vacancies in teaching and non-teaching posts under the university services, in direct recruitment, as conveyed by the Secretary to Govt., Department of personnel vide notification No.F.9 (8)DOP/8-V/90 dated 28th September, 1993 after making necessary amendment in the amended statute 12 of the RAJAU Act.

The list of backward classes has been notified vide Social

Welfare Department Notification No. F.11(1-5)/R&P/SWD/46631

Resolved to defer the matter since the matter is under active consideration of the State Govt. and it is hoped that uniform instructions in this regard are likely to be issued for all the universities of Rajasthan. (Action: REGISTRAR)

It was suggested that in the above committee, one eminent scientist from Ag.Engg. be also included. Further, the Board authorised the Vice-Chancellor to replace any member of the above committee in case some member shows his inability to work on this committee. Honorarium etc. to the members of the committee shall be in accordance with the honorarium to be paid to the members of Quinquennial Review Team of the ICAR. (Action: REGISTRAR)

AU/BOM-30/94-1/526: Considering the following decision taken vide Res.No.AU/DC/94-2/01 (i) in the meeting of the Deans Committee held on 23.4.1994.

" Resolved that the minutes of the various bodies of the university may be printed and circulated to all the Deans and Directors".

However, quarterly return of expenditure from Deans/Directors/

ADRs/OIs on the 10th in the ensuing month at the end of each quarter be ensured. (Action: COMPTROLLER)

<u>AU/BOM-30/94-1/528</u> : Considering revised budget estimates 1993-94 and budget estimates 1994-95 alongwith recommendations made by the Finance Committee in its meeting held on 22.6.1994.

Resolved that revised estimates 1993-94 and budget estimates 1994-95 as recommended by the Finance Committee may be approved. The members observed that the minutes of the meeting of Finance Committee alongwith budget estimates and audit reports for 1987-88 and 1989-90 have been circulated just before the meeting, Hence, in future, such documents be sent to them well in time and possibly with the agenda item of the BOM. The Chairman assured the members that their suggestion shall be honoured faithfully in future.

The minutes of the Finance Committee meeting held on 22.6.1994 were confirmed. However, Director Agriculture, GOR, suggested that university should switch over to the commercial accounting system instead of government accounting procedure.
