Two-days National Seminar on 'Diversification in Agriculture for Enhancing Farmers' Income' was organized by the College of Agriculture, Bikaner at Swami Keshwanand Rajasthan Agricultural University Bikaner during Sept.11-12, 2023. Extension Activities organised for farmers by Directorate of Extension Education (DEE)

- SKRAU, Krishi Vigyan Kendras (KVKs) are undertaking their mandatory activities on a regular basis. Under this, total 137 training programmes were organized by the seven Krishi Vigyan Kendras, benefitting 3454 farmers, farm women, rural youth and field functionaries.
- Under farm advisory (demonstrations), total 1461 demonstrations were laid out on 520.28 ha of land that included pulses, oilseeds and other crops in the reporting period.
- Through different supportive extension services like diagnostic services, farmers visit to KVKs, field visit of scientists, *kisan gathi*, exhibition, telephone helpline, farmers meetings, advisory through Whatsapp groups, *Kisan Chaupal* etc. The outreach was made to farming community under the jurisdiction of seven KVKs of the University.
