- 5. Organise Management Development Programs for training the industry personnel

III. Faculty Chairperson of Community Science, Dr. Vimla Dunkwal proposed the following action points:

Counseling sessions would be arranged for students/teachers from various departments (women welfare department, police department etc.)

- Surveillance system would be installed everywhere in campus for strict vigilance to 2. maintain discipline.
- 3. Interactive sessions would be arranged with stakeholders to fulfill industry requirement.
- 4. Life skills/communication skills development programmes will be implemented.
- 5. Intercollegiate exchange programmes would be initiated.
- 6. Training sessions to develop entrepreneurial skills would be organized.
- 7. Strengthening of the staff positions in college for better execution of responsibilities.
- 8. Anti plagiarism software will be installed for quality research work.
- 9. Efforts will be made to get more projects and funds for institution's development.
- 10. The market linked chain for commercialization of developed value added products would be strengthened.
- 11. Students would be motivated for i-start ups to get employment along with degree programmes.

- IV. Director Extension, Dr. P.S. Shekhawat proposed the following action points for enhancing the outreach programmes of the University for Benefit of the farming community:
- To start training on entrepreneurship development under skill development training 1. programme on Goat rearing.
- Will start one district- One product and increase the intensity of this programme. 2. 3.
- Quality planting material will be produce at KVK level and provide to the farmers 4.
- Seed of high value crops like cumin, isabgol, fenugreek and funnel will be produced at KVK Pokaran and Jaisalmer

Action: Director Extension Education

- Director Research, Dr. Vijay Prakash proposed following points regarding Quality V. Improvement in Agricultural Research:
 - 1. Need based research initiatives as per micro farming conditions will be taken to resolve as per farmer's feed back.
 - 2. Being located in Arid region, terminal heat and drought are very frequent in the zone. Research will be initiated to develop climatic resilient crop varieties of clusterbean, mothbean, pearl millet, taramira, gram, barley and mustard.

- 3. Underground water of this region is saline in nature. Hence, research would be undertaken to utilize saline water to for raising successful crops like cumin, mustard, barley.
- 4. Looking towards scarcity of irrigation water, pressurised irrigation systems (sprinkler/drip) will be refined further to enhance input use efficiency.
- 5. Weed problem in the zone is also intensified, hence there is need to manage weeds by using herbicides and mechanical method.
- 6. Research on Integrated nutrient management and Integrated pest /disease management will be refined further. Experiments would be conducted using liquid bio-fertilizers as well as locally available resources to encourage eco- friendly agri techniques.
- 7. Promotion and awareness programme will be initiated on Natural farming. Demonstration plots will be developed at various research / extension units.
- 8. MoU with reputed Research Institutes will be done to improve quality research.



- 1. Welcome and Introduction: The meeting was called under the Chairmanship of the Honorable Vice Chancellor Dr. Arun Kumar. Dr. P. K. Yadav, Director PM&E welcomed all participants. He introduced the purpose of the meeting, which was to orient the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) committee members about the objectives, strategies, and functions of IQAC in light of NAAC accreditation for S. K. Rajasthan Agricultural University (SKRAU), Bikaner.

- Organizing training programs for entrepreneurship development in areas like mushroom cultivation, honey production, and value addition of fruits and vegetables.
- Enhancing coordination between the college, Directorate of Extension Education (DEE), and Krishi Vigyan Kendras (KVKs) for technology dissemination to farmers' fields.
