Director Agriculture and Dr(Mrs) Pushpa Gupta conveyed their inability to attend the meeting.

Sh. Narpat Singh Rajvi, Dr.S.L.Mehta, Dr.E.A.Siddiq, Secretary Agricultural Production, Secretary Animal Husbandry and Secretary Higher Education could not attend the meeting.

At the outset, the Chairman extended a cordial welcome to members of the Board and mentioned that he was very pleased to welcome Shri G.R.Punia who was attending the meeting for the first time. He hoped that participation of Shri Punia would immensely upgrade capacity of the Board to articulate the vital concerns of RAU and take valuable decisions for shaping the fortune of RAU in a spirit of cooperation and goodwill. The Chairman then highlighted some important events that occurred after the last meeting of the Board of Management. A gist of the highlights is as follows:

- 1. His Excellency Shri Bali Ram Bhagat, Governor of Rajasthan and Chancellor of the University inaugurated the newly constructed building of College of Agriculture, Bikaner on 5th January, 1997. His Excellency commended RAU 's vital role in augmenting agricultural development in Rajasthan and lauded the remarkable progress of the University in past 3 years.
- 2. The Research Advisory Committee and Extension Advisory Meetings were held on 12th December, 1996.

- 3. RAU hosted meetings of ICAR Regional Committee No.6 on January 24 & 25, 1997. These meetings were presided over by Dr. R.S. Paroda, Director General, ICAR and other dignitaries.
- 4. The ICAR issued orders for shifting the Project Coordinating (PC) Unit of AICRP on Arid Legumes from IARI, New Delhi to RAU, Bikaner.

5. RAU developed improved varieties of various crops. Some important ones have been:

Wheat Raj 3777: Identified for NWPZ of the country.

Suitable for very late sown conditions. Average yield 25 q/ha.

Highly resistant against all 3 races of rusts

JOB 666: Identified for saline/alkaline conditions in the country

Average yield 30 q/ha under saline/alkaline conditions

Desi cotton RG 18: Moderately resistant to root rot.

Average seed cotton yield 27 q/ha.

Isabgol RI 89: First variety of Isabgol developed in the state

Average seed yield 12-16 q/ha.

Mothbean FMM 96: Extra early maturing (in 60 days).

Average yield 5-6 q/ha.

- 6. It is a matter of record that in past two and a-half years, 33 new research projects have been sanctioned to RAU by various funding agencies with a total outlay of 734 lacs. These projects have 46 scientific positions along with 107 subordinate staff.
- 7. The Strategic Development Plan has been submitted to the GOR. The Action Plan and Investment Plan have been prepared. The equipment list has been finalized and orders are being placed. The architect for buildings is being appointed and the building work is likely to be started soon.

After detailed discussion, the minutes of the Research Advisory Committee meeting held on 12.12.96 were confirmed. However, some discussion took place regarding SDP recommendation to develop Agriculture Research Station, Mandor as model research station. The Director Research explained the sprit behind this recommendation and said that if this recommendation yielded desired results, in due course of time, depending upon the availability of funds, other research station would also be strengthened.

#### AU/BOM-37/97-1/640

Considering the minutes of the Extension Advisory Committee meeting held on 12.12.96 at Bikaner.

Resolved that the minutes of the Extension Advisory Committee meeting held on 12.12.96 be confirmed with the following observations:

- 1. Problems be identified for extension activities at ARSs and the extension units at ARS, which are at present defunct and non-functional, be strengthened.
- 2. The activities of the Extension Wings located at the colleges be reviewed. Director Ext. Education may coordinate the extension programme at the colleges and the control of Extension Wings be assigned either to the concerned Dean or Director Ext. Education. Necessary budget should also be provided to the Extension Wings for their effective operation.
- 3. Extension units be also started gradually at various ARSs in a phased manner and the concerned Assoc. Director of the Research Centre, may coordinate the activities and manage the technology transfer to the farmers.
- 4. The ADRs of Research Station's should have close linkage with the Incharge of KVK located in their zones.
- 5. While posting the scientists at various KVKs, preferance be given to those who are well conversant with the local language so that farmers of that area may easily grasp the package of practices involved in transfer of technology.

6. The impact of extension activities must be reflected at various ARSs specially at ARS, Durgapura which is located in the capital of the State. To start with Additional manpower and facilities need to be provided at ARS, Durgapura for speedy assessment and transfer of new technology generated by RAU Scientists.
