At first Vice-Chancellor welcomed Prof. Anil Kumar Singh, Vice President, National Academy for Agricultural Sciences, New Delhi, Prof. (Dr.) A.K. Gahlot, Former Vice-Chancellor, RAJUVAS, Bikaner, All Deans/Directors/HODs, Comptroller and Registrar. He informed the house that Hon'ble Chief Minister of the State announced during the budget session to open three new Agriculture Colleges at Hanumangarh, Chandgothi (Churu), and Mandawa (Jhunjhunu) and further informed these colleges will be functional from this session 2021-22. We have already sent the seat matrix to the Sri Karan Narander Agri.Univ., Jobner to fill up the seats. Govt. of Rajasthan have already allotted the land for the college of Chandgothi (Churu), and Mandawa(Jhunjhunu) and land for Agri.College Hanumangarh will be allotted very soon. As per the directives, alternative arrangements have been made to start the Colleges in the nearby Govt. buildings. Dean of the Colleges have already been appointed.

He requested all the members with their constructive suggestions and hope that their decisions will be helpful in the betterment of academic activities.

The Notification issued by Dean, PGS vide No. SKRAU/PGS/AC/01/2021/9522-9525 dated 14.07.2021 was further reviewed and it was resolved to amend the notification in the light of suggestions given by Hon'ble members to reduce penalty beyond permissible semesters to Rs. 20,000.00 per semester uniformly upto 12th semester in P.G. programme. In case of women and person with disability (more than 40%) the penalty was proposed to be reduced to be Rs. 15,000.00 per semester beyond permissible semesters for PG students. 
