Honourable Vice-Chancellor while addressing his
first Academic Council meeting as Chairman welcomed the
academic body and emphasised that the first and the foremost
priority of the University is maintenance of the academic
standard of the highest order. He sought cooperation of
one and all to work in a direction of improving teaching
standards, teaching curricular and stress the importance
of strengthening practicals. He assured that no compromise
would be made to dilute the academic principles. He, further,
assured the teachers that the election process would begun
immediately so as to fulfil the requirements of the Act by
incorporating elected representatives of the teachers on
this body. With this introductory remarks the regular
agenda were taken up.

Item No. 3 - While approving item No. 3, it was emphasised that this previlage of Ph.D. by thesis is granted only to inservice

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candidates and in the subjects wherever Ph.D. by course work in this University is not available. The scheme will commence from 1st of October, 1990 and shall remain operative for a period of five years. However in subjects where Ph.D. by course work exists a modified course work programme shall be operated the details of which shall be provided by the committee.

The permission will be granted strictly on the basis of merit with the maximum of 20 per cent eligible quota. Dean PGS has been directed to workout the mechanism of having preliminary/comprehensive examination for these candidates so as to ensure proper standard and quality of research.

On this it was decided that in future instead of sending the list of the students in favour of getting the attendance condoned by the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, the applications from individual students be sent with justification and recommendation of the Dean for consideration at university level. The University may depute from time to time a representative to check the attendance register as and when necessary.

Considered framing a policy for starting P.G. admissions in Home Science College of this Univ. after the declaration of the results of corresponding classes of Raj. University. This has become necessary to give chance to the meritorious students of Raj. University to get their admissions in P.G. classes of Home Science College of this University.

Resolved that to avoid complications, the admissions be made through Pre-P.G. M.Sc. (Home Science) Test from 1991-92 session. Further, while discussing this item, the action taken by the Dean on the recommendations of the Vice Chancellor for allowing admission to (Miss) Vinita Vyas was confirmed. Further, (Miss) Kavita Bhatnagar D/O Mrs. Suman Bhatnagar who had a higher percentage of marks were also allowed admission in M.Sc (Home Science) as a special case under University employees quota.

Number 23 :

Considered the minutes of the meeting of the committee constituted for examining the cases of B.E (Ag) 3rd year students regarding re-holding of the examination of Agriculture process and farm structure paper in the light of the decision of H.E. the Chancellor.

(i) Since His Excellency the Chancellor has accepted the recommendation of the faculty of CTAE wherein it was emphasised that in view of large portion of out of course questions, confusing and ambiguity in the language of the questions paper may not be treated as walkout and fresh examination be arranged, the Council resolved to accept

the recommendation of the sub-committee constituted by the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor and further recommend that the students may not be deprived of the benefit of Gold Medal, Scholarships and other benefits.

(ii) Regarding the case of 11 students of 3rd year B.E(Ag.) who have failed in one or the other paper of 2nd year B.E.(Ag.) in second make up examination, the Council resolved to accept the recommendations of the committee constituted by the Vice-Chancellor and in light of the qualifications received from Jodhpur University to deal with the parallel cases the benefit of admission to these students who clear the backlog examination in the third attempt be given to the students in the mid session subject to the undertaking given by the students that it will be their entire responsibility to cover up the course and attendance requirements from the date of granting admission. The faculty be also directed to clarify these provisions in their Information Bulletin.

Number 27: June 26, 1990 received from the Secretary, ICAR, New Delhi intimating the qualifications approved by the governing body of ICAR in respect of Engineering & Technological teaching posts.

Resolved that status quo be maintained.

Agenda Item Considered proposal received from the
Number 28 : Chairman, Faculty of Agriculture, regarding starting of Post-Graduate teaching programme and creating a new department of Agro. Meterology at RCA, Udaipur in order to develop a strong Agro Meterology base in Rajasthan.

Resolved to approve the proposed scheme and the course contents. Further resolved that the detailed financial aspect for implementation in phased manners, be examined at University level.

Agenda Item Considered the request received from the
Number 29 : Teachers Association for re-introducing Ph.D. by thesis programme since with the present arrangements experienced guides are called as Co-guides whereas Ph.D. guides of RBS College, Agra gets full credit for the work done by our Teachers. The teachers Association

has further agreed that in order to get sanctity of course work, the teachers can be put to quite a tough Comprehensive Examination.

The matter has already been discussed alongwith Agenda Item No. 6 and decision taken.

Agenda Item Considered the request of Sh. Saleem Ansari
Number 30: who has been admitted provisionally in M.Sc. (Ag.Econ) on the basis of merit he secured in the Pre-PG test but unfortunately in B.Sc.(Ag.) examination he failed to obtain the minimum requirement of 50% marks. Sh. Ansari secured 49.85% marks in B.Sc(Ag) Examination and has prayed for relaxation of 0.15% marks for regularising his provisional admission.

Resolved that no relaxation be agreed to.

Agenda Item Considered imparting special Trainings to
Number 31: the students of this University for encouraging them to appear in the competitive examinations. Deans may consider to prepare long term plans for such trainings. This has become necessary because none from RAJAU have been selected in the Joint CSIR-UGC eligibility test for award of J.R.F. and Lecturership held on 31.12.89.

Resolved that matter be referred to the Chairman faculties to suggest ways and means to encourage and guide the students for competitive examinations at State as well as National level.

Agenda Item Considered following decisions taken in
Number 32: the meeting of the Staff Council SKN College of Agriculture, Jobner held on 9th August, 1990 while considering the memorandum submitted by the students of the college -

(1) Regarding switching over to 4.00 scale in

place of 10.00 scale presently followed in our University it was resolved that this may be revived because it has become difficult for our students to compete with the students of other Universities for admission in IARI. Further most of the Agril. Universities in the country have not switched over to 10.00 scale.

- (2) Regarding granting of scholarships to all M.Sc. and Ph.D. students based on self employment scheme, a lump sum provision be made in the State Plan Budget of the College for the year 1991.

i) Switching over to 4.00 point scale - The matter has already been discussed alongwith agenda item No.3 (Item No. 5(k), and decision taken.
