### Weather Forecast and Agromet Advisory

Period 04<sup>th</sup> October 2024 to 08<sup>th</sup> October 2024

<b>Weather review of last week:</b> During this period, the maximum temperature ranged between 38.6 to 40.7 °C and the minimum temperature ranged between 23.8 to 24.4°C. During this period, low wind speed observed with RH values of 94 % to 98%.		<b>Weather forecast for the coming week:</b> On the basis of the information received from the India Meteorological Department, New Delhi and Regional Meteorological Centre, Jaipur, weather for the next 5 days in Bikaner district (04.10.2024 to 08.10.2024) clear sky on 04.10.2024 to 05.10.2024, partially cloudy on 06.10.2024 & 08.10.2024 and cloudy on 07.10.2024. T <sub>min</sub> will possibly range between 25.0-26.0°C and the T <sub>max</sub> is likely to remain between 37.0-38.0 °C. During this period, high wind velocity is likely to blow from then South-South-West, South-West, West-North-West and North-West directions.

<b>Agro Advisory:</b> Based on the weather review of last week and the weather forecast for this week, the following advice is given to the farmer.						
<b>Specific advisory</b>	Conserve every drop of water and moisture for future. For the control of sucking pests (jassids, white fly, thrips etc) in cotton spray acetamiprid or thiamethoxam @ 5 g/15 litre water.					
<b>Crop</b>	<b>Stage</b>	<b>Details</b>	<b>Agro Advisory</b>			
Groundnut	Pegging & Pod formation	Insect Control	In groundnut for the management of leaf eating caterpillar spray of Indoxacarb 14.5 SC @ 0.8 ml/lit or Emamectin benzoate 5 SG @ 0.5 gm/lit of water found effective.			
		Disease management	Prevailing and forecasted weather conditions may increase the chances of tikka disease in groundnut. Therefore, farmers are advised to spray of Mencozeb @ 2 gram per litre of water.			
Sesame	Flowering	Insect Control	In case of infestation of caterpillar infestation in crop, spray of Indoxacab 14.5 SC 1 ml or Emamectin Benzoate 5 SG at the rate of 0.5 gram per liter of water.			
Moth/mung bean	Maturity	Harvesting	Harvest mothbean and mungbean crop at physiological maturity stage prior to shattering losses.			
<b>Special advisory</b>			<b>Washing powder or other additive must be added in standing crop sprays.</b>			
Horticulture		Irrigation	Irrigate date palm, Kinnow, orange and lemon orchards on regular interval. To control fruit fly attack in ber spray of fenvalerate/dimethoate @ 1 ml/ liter of water at pea stage of ber fruits.			
Milch animal		Feeding	Feed 20 to 50 gram mineral mixture to each milch animal according their body weight to maintain health and to avoid the problems like milk fever and prolapse.
