Weather Forecast and Agromet Advisory

Period 07th April 2026 to 11th April 2026

Weather review of last week: During this period, the maximum temperature ranged between 14.9 to 19.9 °C and the minimum temperature ranged between 3.8 to 6.5°C. During this period, low wind speed observed with RH values of 65% to 95%.	Weather forecast for the coming week: On the basis of the information received from the India Meteorological Department, New Delhi and Regional Meteorological Centre, Jaipur, weather for the next 5 days in Bikaner district (07.04.2026 to 11.04.2026) dense cloudy on 07.04.2026, cloudy on 08.04.2026, overcast on 09.04.2026 to 10.04.2026 and partially cloudy on 11.04.2026. T _{min} will 15.0-19.0°C and the T _{max} is likely to remain between 30.0-36.0 °C. During this period low to moderate wind velocity is likely to blow coupled with low relative humidity. Winds will blow from the North-North-East, East-North-East, South-South-West and North-North-West directions.

Agro Advisory: Based on the weather review of last week and the weather forecast for this week, the following advices are for the farmers.

Specific advisory	In view of the predicted weather conditions, the harvested/matured crops should be stored and protected safely. Rabi weeds mature along with the crops; therefore, to prevent their spread in the future, harvest carefully and destroy the weeds.		
Crop	Stage	Details	Agro Advisory
Wheat	Maturity	Harvesting	Harvest the crop at physiological maturity and protect it
Mustard	Maturity	Harvesting	To prevent scattering of pods of mustard, crop harvest at physiological maturity stage and protect it.
Fenugreek	Maturity	Harvesting	In timely sown fenugreek crop, to prevent scattering of pods crop harvest timely and protect harvested crop.
Zaid Moong and Vegetables	Sowing		Proper time for sowing of Zaid Moong and vegetables such as okra, watermelon, muskmelon tinda, cucumber, long melon. Suitable varieties for Zaid Moong are SML-668, RMG-62 and RMG-492.
Horticulture			Avoid spraying any kind of chemical in crops of cucurbit vegetables till the weather is clear.
Forage management			Sowing of RBC -2 or Giant Bajra are better for green fodder supply during summers.
Livestock		Health management	Adopt preventive measures against mastitis in milch animals. Vaccinate the livestock animals against foot and mouth disease and provide oral dose of medicine against stomach worms Provide good quality drinking water to animals.
